



40 DAY PRAYER CARDS

ENCOUNTER GOD.
RECEIVE HIS VISION.
LIVE HIS MISSION.

PRAYER IS YOUR **DIRECT LINE** OF COMMUNICATION WITH GOD!

It's an invitation to a personal relationship with the Creator of the universe.

God loves to answer our prayers, but oftentimes, we're too rushed or distracted to see it. His answers may not be what we want or expect, but they're always a reflection of His character.

God is trustworthy and good. The question is, do you pray like you believe that?

Over the next 40 days, make space to pause, seek, listen, and respond because prayer is just as much about listening as it is about asking.

HOW TO USE THESE CARDS

Use these cards daily to grow closer to God, realign your heart with His vision, and grow in courageous obedience. Every card has something on both sides to guide you.

The front of every card uses the acronym **PRAY**.

Pause to be still.

Reflect on who God is and what His Word says.

Ask Him for what you want and need.

Yield or surrender your desires to Him.

On the back of every card, you'll see a missional prayer theme to guide you.

Days 1-10: Vision Renewal

Days 11-20: Raise the Next Generation

Days 21-30: Advocate for the Vulnerable

Days 31-40: Mobilize Missional Leaders

IDEAS TO ESTABLISH RHYTHMS

Practice stillness. Don't rush past this time. Find a place and time where you can be undistracted.

Practice silence. Quiet your heart before the Lord. Sit in the silence and listen to the Spirit.

Practice posture. You can kneel, sit on the floor, or raise your hands. Pray loudly or whisper. Engage your heart, mind, and body!

Practice accountability. Invite someone into your prayer journey. Share what you're learning and asking for with them.

Practice community. You can also use these cards with others. Whether it's your family, spouse, roommates, or friends, you can pray together.

DAY 1: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still.
Thank God for His greatness.

REFLECT: God's personal name is Yahweh, "I AM." What does this show you about God?

EXODUS 3:14

God said to Moses, "I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I am has sent me to you.'"

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to prepare your heart for what He wants to teach you on this journey.

YIELD: Identify what's keeping you back from trusting God. Like Moses, perhaps it's fear and insecurity. Surrender it to the Lord today.

Pray for **VISION RENEWAL**

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

ISAIAH 43:19

*See, I am doing a new thing!
Now it springs up; do you not
perceive it? I am making a way in
the wilderness and streams in the
wasteland.*

PRAY FOR YOUR FAITH

- God, what do you want for my relationship with You?
- Deepen my knowledge of You and my trust in You.
- Give me eyes to see what new things You are doing in my life, in Your church, and in the world.

DAY 2: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still.
Thank God for being your
heavenly Father.

REFLECT: God is your perfect Father who
made you part of His family
through Jesus. What does this
mean for you?

1 JOHN 3:1

*See what great love the Father has
lavished on us, that we should be
called children of God! And that is
what we are!*

ASK: Make your requests known to your
Father in heaven. Ask Him to show
you what it means to be His child.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns
to God. Tell Him you're here to submit
to His heart and ways.

Pray for **VISION RENEWAL**

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

ISAIAH 64:1

Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains would tremble before you!

PRAY FOR YOUR FAMILY

- God, what do you want for my relationship with my family?
- Show me how to love my family sacrificially and point them to You.
- I want to be changed by Your presence. Disrupt my plans and routines to see You today.

DAY 3: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for Jesus.

REFLECT: God sent Jesus to save you and be your friend. What does this mean for you?

JOHN 15:15

I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you.

ASK: Make your requests known to Jesus, Your Savior and Friend. Ask Him to show you the Father's ways.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray for **VISION RENEWAL**

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

PSALM 85:6

Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?

PRAY FOR YOUR FRIENDSHIPS

- God, what do you want for my friendships?
- Show me how to be a better friend who loves in grace and truth.
- Revive my heart to seek holiness in every area and relationship in my life.

DAY 4: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for Jesus.

REFLECT: God sent His Holy Spirit to be your helper. What does this mean for you?

JOHN 14:26 (ESV)

But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

ASK: Make your requests known to the Holy Spirit. Ask Him to teach and remind you of truth today.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray for **VISION RENEWAL**

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

REVELATION 2:4-5

Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken the love you had at first. Consider how far you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.

PRAY FOR YOUR PRIORITIES

- God, how have I forsaken You as my first love?
- Help me realign my priorities to fit Your design.
- I repent of putting other things before You. Holy Spirit, show me where to focus my attention.

DAY 5: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His sovereignty.

REFLECT: God exists outside of time. What does this mean to you?

PSALM 90:2

Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the whole world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to restore awe and wonder for who He is.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray for **VISION RENEWAL**

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

LAMENTATIONS 5:21

Restore us to yourself, Lord, that we may return; renew our days as of old.

PRAY FOR YOUR TIME

- God, what do You want for my time?
- Help me to use my time to honor You and love others.
- Restore my heart, Lord. I pray I will serve and enjoy You every single day.

DAY 6: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His generosity.

REFLECT: God is a good gift giver. What does this mean to you?

JAMES 1:17

Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him for eyes to see the gifts He's giving you.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray for VISION RENEWAL

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

JOEL 2:28

And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.

PRAY FOR YOUR SERVICE

- God, what do I have that I can use for Your kingdom?
- Awaken the spiritual gifts in me that You want me to use.
- Holy Spirit, fill me afresh today. Show me who I can encourage.

DAY 7: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His provision.

REFLECT: God is Jehovah Jireh, the God who provides. What does this mean to you?

PHILIPPIANS 4:19

And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to meet your needs.

YIELD: Surrender any fears around generosity to God. Tell Him you want to manage the resources He's given you wisely.

Pray for **VISION RENEWAL**

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

PSALM 119:36-37

Turn my heart toward your statutes and not toward selfish gain. Turn my eyes away from worthless things; preserve my life according to your word.

PRAY FOR YOUR GENEROSITY

- God, how can I change to see You as the owner of everything in my life?
- Thank you for the opportunity to use my availability, gifts, and resources. Show me how to be a good steward of what You've given me.
- Help me cultivate a greater generosity and dependency on You with my finances.

DAY 8: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for never changing.

REFLECT: God is the only constant thing in your life. What does this mean to you?

HEBREWS 13:8

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to fill you with His peace knowing that He never changes.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray for **VISION RENEWAL**

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

2 CHRONICLES 7:14

If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

PRAY FOR YOUR PRESENT

- God, what do You want to do in my life right now?
- I humbly seek You and repent of my wicked ways. I receive Your forgiveness today.
- Help me fix my mind on You, place my trust in You, and surrender all control to You.

DAY 9: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His presence.

REFLECT: God promises never to leave you. What does this mean to you?

DEUTERONOMY 31:8

The Lord himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to make His presence known to you.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray for VISION RENEWAL

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

PSALM 27: 13-14

I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord.

PRAY FOR YOUR FUTURE

- God, what are You preparing me for?
- I trust You hold the future, Lord.
Give me the courage to follow You wherever You lead.
- Show me the next steps to take.

DAY 10: VISION RENEWAL

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for being the Creator.

REFLECT: God made you in His image. What does this mean to you?

GENESIS 1:27

So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to help you walk securely as His image bearer.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray for VISION RENEWAL

Father, show me Yourself and Your vision. Show me what You want for my life and Your people.

HABAKUK 3:2

Lord, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, Lord. Repeat them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy.

PRAY FOR YOUR PURPOSE

- God, what unique purpose do You have for my life?
- You're an awesome God, Lord. I invite You to work in and through me.
- Do it again, Lord. Bring new life and vision, and bring more people to Your family.

DAY 11: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His strength.

REFLECT: In our weakness, God makes us strong. What does this mean to you?

2 CORINTHIANS 12:9

But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to make you strong in your weaknesses.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

PROVERBS 22:6

Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it.

PRAY FOR CHILDREN

- Lord, I lift up all the children in the world today. May they see and know You.
- Be with all those who care for children, giving them hearts of compassion and wisdom.
- Use Your church to love children and to show them how they can follow You.

DAY 12: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His reliability.

REFLECT: God will always equip you for what He wants you to do. What does this mean to you?

HEBREWS 13:20-21

Now may the God of peace . . . equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to make you strong in your weaknesses.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

1 TIMOTHY 4:12

Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.

PRAY FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS

- Father, show Yourself to students in middle school so they can know Your purpose for their lives.
- Bring parents and other encouraging role models who will call them to a life of integrity.
- Use Your church to build confidence in these children so they know who You say they are.

DAY 13: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His steadiness.

REFLECT: God is the source of your identity and confidence. What does this mean to you?

2 CORINTHIANS 3:4-5

Such confidence we have through Christ before God. Not that we are competent in ourselves to claim anything for ourselves, but our competence comes from God.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to make you confident in His character.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

MALACHI 4:6

He will turn the hearts of the parents to their children, and the hearts of the children to their parents; or else I will come and strike the land with total destruction.

PRAY FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

- Father, do this again. Soften the hearts of teens towards their parents.
- Equip parents with wisdom, patience, and love to guide their children.
- Use Your church to empower and inspire youth in their faith to make it their own.

DAY 14: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His invitation to co-labor with Him.

REFLECT: God is the one who brings spiritual growth. What does this mean to you?

1 CORINTHIANS 3:6, 9

I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow . . . For we are co-workers in God's service; you are God's field, God's building.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to grow the seeds you've been planting and watering in the people around you.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

2 TIMOTHY 1:6-7

For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands. For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

PRAY FOR YOUNG ADULTS

- Father, continue reviving the hearts of young adults around the world to know and surrender to You.
- Grow a spirit of courage, humility, obedience, and devotion in them.
- Use Your church to give young adults a place to discover and use their God-given gifts.

DAY 15: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for Jesus' invitation.

REFLECT: Jesus invites you to follow Him without knowing the details at times. What does this mean to you?

MATTHEW 16:24-25

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it."

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to grow the seeds you've been planting and watering in the people around you.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

2 TIMOTHY 2:2

And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others.

PRAY FOR KIDS AND YOUTH MINISTRY

- Lord, give all those working with kids and youth an outpouring of Your grace, love, and passion.
- Draw more kids to church spaces where they can find authentic community, good role models, and biblical teaching.
- Awaken people in Your church to ways they can intentionally spend time pouring into the next generation.

DAY 16: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for being all knowing.

REFLECT: God deeply and completely knows you. What does this mean to you?

PSALM 139:1-2

You have searched me, Lord, and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to help you know Him better.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

PSALM 145:4

One generation commends your works to another; they tell of your mighty acts.

PRAY FOR YOUNG COUPLES

- Lord, lead young couples to put You at the center of their relationship.
- Turn their hearts to Your instruction so they may honor You in their relationship.
- Help young people discover that their heart's desire for intimacy is ultimately found in You.

DAY 17: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for being your perfect Father.

REFLECT: There's nothing in the world that can separate us from God's love. What does this mean to you?

ROMANS 8:38-39

For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to show you the depths of His love for you.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

DEUTERONOMY 6:6-7

These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

PRAY FOR PARENTS

- Father, show parents how much You love them for who they are.
- Draw them close to You so their parenting is an overflow of their relationship with You.
- Give parents perseverance in difficulties, a supportive community, and creativity in leading their children.

DAY 18: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for complete access to Him.

REFLECT: Through Jesus, we become part of God's family and people. What does this mean to you?

1 PETER 2:9

But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to show you where you can live more fully in light.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

ROMANS 8:14, 17

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God . . . Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

PRAY FOR GOD-GIVEN IDENTITY

- Lord, help Your people build their foundation firmly on Your truth.
- Make our identity in Christ, as a chosen people who live in the light, deeply rooted in our hearts.
- Give us a holy perspective on suffering as it transforms us more into Your image.

DAY 19: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for ever-present help.

REFLECT: As a believer, the Holy Spirit dwells inside of you. What does this mean to you?

ROMANS 8:11

And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask the Holy Spirit to breathe life into any areas that need it.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

3 JOHN 1:4

I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.

PRAY FOR GODLY INFLUENCES

- Lord, shape and mold us to be holy influences in the lives of those around us.
- In a world where many voices influence the next generation, make godly voices louder.
- Help your children to walk in truth and love so that others can see who You are in us.

DAY 20: RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His good plans.

REFLECT: When you surrender to Jesus, you let God be the author of your story. What does this mean to you?

PSALM 139:16

Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to show you what He's doing with your story.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to RAISE THE NEXT GENERATION

Father, inspire young generations to follow You boldly. Show me how to invest in those just a few steps behind me.

PSALM 78:4

We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done.

PRAY FOR YOUR LEGACY

- Lord, show me how to live for You and not myself.
- Grow my faith and courage to obey You when it's scary.
- Help me take the right next step to make disciples and pass down a legacy of serving You.

DAY 21: ADVOCATE FOR THE VULNERABLE

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for saving you.

REFLECT: Jesus died to save you and bridge the gap between you and God. What does this mean to you?

ROMANS 5:7-8

Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to restore the joy of your salvation.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to **ADVOCATE FOR THE VULNERABLE**

Father, break my heart for what breaks Yours. Show me how to be a voice for the voiceless.

MICAH 6:8

He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.

PRAY FOR THE LOST

- God, reveal Yourself to all who are broken, lost, and hurting.
- I pray by name for people in my life who are far from You. Encounter them, Lord.
- Help me to act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with You.

DAY 22: ADVOCATE FOR THE VULNERABLE

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for being your dwelling place.

REFLECT: No matter where you go, God is your home. What does this mean to you?

PSALM 90:1

Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to help you rest in His arms.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to **ADVOCATE FOR THE VULNERABLE**

Father, break my heart for what breaks Yours. Show me how to be a voice for the voiceless.

JAMES 1:27

Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.

PRAY FOR FOSTER CARE

- Bring every child in crisis to a loving home and comfort them on their journey.
- Raise up more people in Your church to generously open their homes and hearts to children in foster care.
- Strengthen foster parents and all who care for the hurting children in our communities.

DAY 23: ADVOCATE FOR THE VULNERABLE

PAUSE: Take a moment to be still. Thank God for His renewal.

REFLECT: God makes you new and invites you into His ministry of reconciliation. What does this mean to you?

2 CORINTHIANS 5:17-18

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.

ASK: Make your requests known to God. Ask Him to help you walk in newness.

YIELD: Surrender your desires and concerns to God. Tell Him you're here to submit to His heart and ways.

Pray to **ADVOCATE FOR THE VULNERABLE**

Father, break my heart for what breaks Yours. Show me how to be a voice for the voiceless.

ISAIAH 58:6

Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke?

PRAY FOR RECOVERY

- Lord, get the attention of those who are struggling with addiction.
- Bring healing and reconciliation to those in recovery centers. Open their eyes to see You clearly.
